

Indian Wells Valley Dolphins Swim Team

Ridgecrest, CA, 16-17 May 2009

Facilities: Sgt. Pinney Memorial Pool, 205 South Warner St., is owned and operated by the City of Ridgecrest. It is a 25-yard, 6 lane outdoor pool, with a small warm-up/cool-down area, showers/change/restrooms (M&F), concession stand, adjacent shade trees and grass. The competition pool has not been certified in accordance with USAS Rules 104.2.2(C).

Directions: From Bakersfield area: 58 East, then 14 North, then 178 East (Inyokern Road) into Ridgecrest. Turn right (south) on China Lake Blvd (2nd signal). Turn right (west) on Ridgecrest Blvd. Turn left (south) on Warner (1st left). Pool is on the right (west side of Warner St).
From Bishop/Mammoth area: 395 South, then 178 East (Inyokern Road) into Ridgecrest. Continue to pool as described above.

Date & Time: Saturday & Sunday, 16-17 May 2009. Meet begins at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday and 8:30 a.m. on Sunday. A coaches & officials meeting will be conducted one-half hour before the start of each day of the meet.

- Entries:**
1. Only one swimmer per entry form.
 2. Entry fees for individual events will be \$2.50 per event.
 3. Entry fees for relays will be \$5.00 per relay team. All relays will be deck-entered.
 4. Payment by entire team is preferred to separate payments for individual swimmers.
 5. Please provide all information requested on enclosed entry form. Entries should be sent to:

 6. Teams may submit consolidated entries using HY-TEK Commlink file by email or CD. Hard copy of electronic entries is also required.
 7. Please provide name of USA certified stroke and turn officials at time of entry.

Deadline: Entries must be received by Friday, May 8th 2009. Late entries will be accepted on a space available basis up to 8:30 AM Saturday May 16th and will incur a \$10 late fee per swimmer. Entries accepted past the May 8th deadline may not be listed on the meet program or psych-sheet. Meet fees not received via mail will be paid to the Clerk of Course at meet check in.

- Rules:**
1. 2009 USA Swimming rules will apply.
 2. Heats will be seeded based on best-entered yard times.
 3. Swimmers must compete in the age group based on their age on May 16, 2009. Masters swimmers are welcome to enter in the 15 & over age group but are not eligible for awards.
 4. Meet will be deck seeded using a master check-in system. Swimmers in the first 4 events must check in by 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, and 8:00 on Sunday. Swimmers in other events must check in no later than one hour prior to the estimated start of their first event based on the projected timeline in the meet program. Swimmers 8 & under will be corralled by Clerk of Course.
 5. All events are timed finals.
 6. Swimmers are limited to five individual events and one relay on Saturday, and four individual events and one relay on Sunday.
 7. Open events are open to swimmers of all ages and provide opportunities for younger swimmers to receive official times in longer events. Scoring in Open events is **NOT broken out by age group**, so younger swimmers in these events will likely receive fewer points than if they compete in their age group events.
 8. Relay rules: 1) Mixed relay teams may not be all girls or all boys. 2) A maximum of two boys may be on relay teams. 3) Up to 2 relay team members may be moved up one age group. 4) Relay entries with swimmers from more than one team are acceptable but are not eligible for awards.

Timers: Lanes will be assigned to teams based on the number of swimmers entered. Please provide sufficient timers to fill the assigned lanes when requested by the head timer on the day of the meet.

Officials: USA certified officials are encouraged to volunteer their services to work the meet. A USA Swimming certified official must be provided for every ten or more swimmers. Please check-in with the Meet Referee on the day of the meet. If an insufficient number of officials are present to run the meet, a ten-minute break will be taken every two hours.

Awards: Individual Events - Medals will be awarded for 1st through 3rd places and ribbons will be awarded for 4th through 12th places in each age group.

- Age groups will be swum together and awarded separately. Each line on the event list represents one set of awards.
- Some events are awarded in 1-year age groups and others in multiple-year age groups. See the event list for details.
- Swimmers 13-18 will receive awards **by request only**. Contact the awards table for your awards, or request awards when you check in with Clerk of Course.
- Swimmers 19-and-over are not eligible for awards in any event.

Relay Events – Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th places in each age group for relays. Note that NO MEDALS are awarded for relays.

Individual High Point - High point awards will be awarded to boys and girls winners in age groups: 6 and under, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13-14, and 15-18.

Team High Point - Team trophies will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place.

Participant Awards - Swimmers not placing in any event will receive participant ribbons. Please contact Clerk of Course.

Scoring: Individual Events - 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 points for 1st through 6th place, respectively. High point scoring will be based on placement in the event age group as shown in the event list (each line in the event list represents 1 set of points and awards).

Relay Events – 14, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 points for 1st through 6th place, respectively.

Warm-up: Teams will be assigned warm-up lanes.

On Saturday, warm-up for Ridgecrest teams will be from 7:00 to 7:50. Warm-ups for other teams will be: 10 & under from 7:50 to 8:15, and 11 & up from 8:15 to 8:45.

On Sunday, warm-up for Ridgecrest teams will be from 6:30 to 7:20. Warm-ups for other teams will be: 10 & under from 7:20 to 7:45, and 11 & up from 7:45 to 8:15.

Concessions: A concession stand will be open to provide breakfast, lunch, drinks, and snacks.

Misc: Self-contained RVs may park overnight across the street from the swimming pool, in the Kerr-McGee Community Center parking lot. Please park only on the west side of the parking lot near the pine trees.




