

III. Violations and minimum penalties

(Applicable to players, parents and coaches from time of departure until time of return from all swim practices and swim meets)

Act

1. First ejection of player, parent or coach from a contest or Scrimmage for unsportsmanlike conduct.

2. An ejected coach, player or parent must leave the site of the event. This person may have no contact with his/her team during the remainder of the event.

3. A swim council board (President, Secretary, one elected member) will determine what sanctions will be enforced against swimmer, parent, or coach. Depending on the nature of the infraction. The swimmer, parent, or coach may be suspended for a number of meets or for the remainder of the season.

Penalties

Ineligible for the next KSC contest or event to be carried over to next season.

APPEALS PROCEDURE... First and Second Ejection

An appeal of the ineligibility of a player, parent or coach may be made in writing to the KSC Eligibility Committee. The committee will act with due diligence and their decision is final.

PHYSICAL ASSAULT

Any parent/guardian, fan, player or coach who physically assaults an event official or coach shall be banned for the remainder of the season. An event official is defined as a referee, umpire or any other official assigned to interpret or enforce rules of competition at an event.
